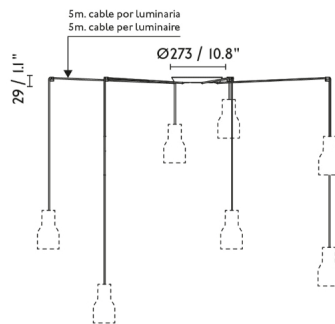




TATAWIN M is a family of light fixtures designed by Adolfo Abejón. The shape of the shade is reminiscent of the upper part of the characteristic houses of Tataouine, a city in southeast Tunisia. It is ideal for creating compositions from a single point of light both in contract spaces and in the home. Version with gloss black glass shade and multiple 7 - light ceiling rose. Lighting solutions designed for global markets, compatible with mains voltages: 110 - 120V and 220 - 240V.
